Colorado Measures of Academic Success Science & Social Studies (CMAS) (4th, 5th Grades)

The Colorado Measures of Academic Success (CMAS): Science and Social Studies is Colorado's standards-based assessment designed to measure the Colorado Academic Standards (CAS) in the content areas of science and social studies. A very small number of students with significant cognitive disabilities may take the Colorado Alternate Assessment (CoAlt) based on the Extended Evidence Outcomes (EEOs) of the CAS. The CMAS and CoAlt: Science and Social Studies assessments are collaboratively developed by the Colorado Department of Education, the Colorado educator community, and Colorado's science and social studies assessment contractor, Pearson. CMAS is a state mandated test. This test will be administered to a sampling of grades 4 and 7 (as determined by the CDE).

These assessments range from 60-110 minutes per unit and the testing window for CMAS Science and Social Studies is **April 10-28**.

Colorado Measures of Academic Success ELA & MATH (PARCC) (3rd, 4th, 5th Grades)

In compliance with legislation, Colorado joined the PARCC consortia as a governing member in August, 2012. PARCC is a multi-state assessment consortium that is developing shared English language arts (ELA) and mathematics assessments. PARCC is a state mandated test. PARCC assessments in English Language Arts/Literacy and Mathematics will be administered in grades 3-9 in the 2015-16 school year. Tests at each grade level will be based on the Common Core State Standards (CCSS) for that grade level. These assessments range from 60-110 minutes per unit.

The testing window for CMAS ELA and MATH is **March 13 - April 28**.

English Language Proficiency Assessment (ACCESS for ELLs) (K -5th)

In 2016-17, the WIDA Consortium will administer the annual summative assessment, ACCESS for ELLs 2.0. An online assessment replaces paper-based version of ACCESS for ELLs for Grades 1-12,

although a paper-based assessment will continue to be available according to each state's guidelines for the new assessments. Like ACCESS for ELLs, the new assessment will allow educators, students, and families to monitor students' progress in acquiring academic English in the domains of speaking, listening, reading, and writing and will be aligned with the WIDA English Language Development (ELD) Standards. These assessments range from 35-65 minutes per unit.

Testing window for the ACCESS test is **January 9 - February 10**.

MAP Testing (K -5th Grades)

Measures of Academic Progress® (MAP®) – These computerized tests are adaptive and offered in Reading, Language Usage, and Mathematics. When taking a MAP® test, the difficulty of each question is based on how well a student answers all the previous questions. As the student answers correctly, questions become more difficult. If the student answers incorrectly, the questions become easier. In an optimal test, a student answers approximately half the items correctly and half incorrectly. The final score is an estimate of the student's achievement level. This assessment is between 45-55 minutes per subject.

Star Early Literacy

In accordance with the Colorado READ act (Reading to Ensure Academic Readiness) SEL assessments are given to all students grades Kindergarten to 3rd grade to screen for a significant reading deficiency. The SEL assessment measures basic reading, comprehension, phonemic awareness, and oral language skills. This assessment is designed to only 35-45 minutes, and is given three times a year as required by the state.
